After being released from prison in April, Tony has been living in a transitional facility. He has been focused on his own healing and growth, and connecting with his family. He is learning how to drive and working full-time! Tony has the full support of his family and the Khamisa Family. He also knows he has the support of the TKF family and this means a lot to him.

We are very proud of Tony, his courage, his strength and his commitment to spreading peace. Tony is doing well and you will hear from him soon!

The next step is for Tony to achieve more independence when he is ready by moving out of his transitional facility. We will continue to give Tony space and privacy. TKF will refrain from providing any additional public details, and we will decline to participate in any public interviews during this adjustment period. We ask you to join us in respecting this approach. There will be many months and years ahead to tell Tony's story in support of TKF's mission to create safer schools and communities.
